

Leon Dormido Crianza

A Crianza wine must always show a delicate balance between fruit and oak, body and elegance. Nothing must stand out. We also want to bring harmony between the Alta and Baja regions, and we have harvested Tempranillo vines from the town of San Vicente (Alta) and Graciano grapes from Tudelilla (Baja).

Tempranillo brings classy, velvet and balsamic touches, and Graciano offers fruit, colour and character. The wine has then rested in American oak barrels for over one year to settle down.



Dark red colour with purple hints.

Black berry aromas (blueberries) from Tempranillo blend well with the acid, red touches from Graciano (cranberries, wild strawberries). Ageing in oak bring toasted notes of cacao and spices (black pepper, clove).

Upfront fruit, fresh and intense start, with ripe and round tannins. Vanillas and spices from the oak. Long and pleasant finish, not drying at all.

Have with all sort of barbeques, stews, cheeses and, why not, sweets. On its own is not bad either.
