

## Leon Dormido Young Red

All the grapes come from the Rioja Baja region, in the Eastern part of the DOC Rioja, which is the “Mediterranean Rioja” (warmer and drier climate with lots of sun exposure). This region can be a bit too warm in the valley, but the slopes of the Yerga range host some of the most interesting vineyards in Rioja, especially for young, fruity, smooth wines.

This young wine comes from the grapes of La Montesa vineyard, with an altitude of 500 metres above sea level, and clay and calcareous soils. 50% of the grapes are Garnacha, which brings blooms of fruit to the wine. The other 50% is Tempranillo, which adds finesse, elegance, acidity and persistent aromas.



Intense ruby red colour with purple hints. Red berry aromas from the Garnacha (cranberries) combined with more dry and serious touches from Tempranillo (tea, tobacco, liquorice). Mediterranean spices and balsamic background.

Perfect with all kind of appetizers, oriental cuisine, salads, cheese and on its own.
